## What's a Musical Marathon?

The Musical Marathon is 8 hours of musical fun featuring lots of playing, sight-reading and drawings for prizes. You must be present to win!

## Schedule of Activities:

8:00am - 11:30am	Division I orchestra rehearsal ( <i>mandatory!!</i> )
11:30am - 12:00pm	Division I lunch break (bring your own sack lunch)
12:00pm - 4:30pm	Division I members will be joined by Division II, III, and IV members (Division II, III, IV do NOT need to arrive before 11:30am)

## General Marathon Information:

- Drawings for prizes will be held every half hour during the afternoon rehearsal. The number of prizes given away each half hour will depend on the number of prizes donated.
- You must be present in order to win (except for the special \$100 drawing).
- Minimum pledge is \$1
- For money collected and turned in on or before February 11th, you will receive 2 raffle tickets for every \$5. For pledges received by February 11th where no money has yet been collected, you will receive 1 raffle ticket for every \$5 pledged.
- Each MYS member who participates in the afternoon activities will automatically receive 5 raffle tickets.
- Money collected will go to the Metropolitan Youth Symphony operating budget.
- Your job will be easier if you can collect the money as pledges are taken. It is your responsibility to collect the pledges!
- **Division I** members are **required** to be present in the morning but they are encouraged to stay all day. **Remember - the prize drawings are in the afternoon.**

## Taking and Collecting Marathon Pledges:

- Ask your neighbors, friends, and family to make pledges. Minimum donation is \$1.
- **We do not recommend you go to homes of people you don't know unless you are accompanied by an adult!!**
- Pledge money collected can be turned in to your rehearsal aide at rehearsals. You must turn in a pledge sheet at the same time money is turned in. You may have as many pledge sheets as you need. You will receive your drawing tickets on the day of the Marathon.
